While most people think of Venice when it comes to canals, Milan actually has its own network of canals,


known as the Navigli. Once used for transporting goods, these


picturesque waterways are now lined with trendy cafes, galleries, and restaurants, offering a unique side of the city, especially when explored by boat.







THE SECOND LOFE OF INSPECTOR CANESSA


