



• São Bento Station:

• Alves & Co. by Eça de Queirós


A witty and sharp critique of bourgeois morality in 19th-century Porto, exploring infidelity and business intrigue.


• A Capital by Eça de Queirós

A tale of shattered dreams and social critique, with contrasts between Lisbon and Porto shaping the protagonist's journey.


• The Wind Whistling in the Cranes by Lídia Jorge


A haunting and lyrical novel that delves into the tensions of a changing Portugal, where tradition meets modernity through the lens of migration and class struggle near Porto.

A poignant and deeply human exploration of women's lives in contemporary Porto, full of interconnected struggles and triumphs.


• Os Maias by Eça de Queirós

• O Pintor Debaixo do Lava-Loiças by Afonso Cruz


A whimsical and philosophical novel where Porto becomes one of the surreal landscapes for Cruz's imaginative reflections.
