Inspire Dance Academy

Terms & Conditions

By registering with Inspire Dance Academy (IDA), all parents, guardians, and students agree to comply with the following Terms & Conditions.

Fees & Payments

Class fees are payable monthly in advance via GoCardless and are collected on the 1st of each month.

All class fees are non-refundable.

Fees are charged to secure and retain a student's place within their class, regardless of attendance.

In the event of illness, injury, holidays, or other absence, full fees remain payable in order to hold the student's place within the class.

A £15 late payment charge will be added to any failed GoCardless payment that requires retrying.

If payments lapse or remain unpaid, Inspire Dance Academy reserves the right to suspend or withdraw a student's place within the class.

Notice Periods & Cancellation

A minimum of four weeks' written notice is required to cancel any class or membership.

Notice must be provided in writing via email.

Full fees remain payable throughout the notice period.

Failure to provide the required notice may result in continued charges during this period.

Additional Costs

Show fees, examination fees, competition entries, costumes, uniform, and workshop fees are not included within regular class fees and will be charged separately where applicable.

Participation in examinations, performances, competitions, and shows may be subject to additional rehearsal requirements and associated costs.

Attendance & Punctuality

Regular attendance is encouraged to support student progress and class development.

Students should arrive promptly and ready for class in the correct uniform.

Inspire Dance Academy reserves the right to review examination, competition, or performance entries where attendance is consistently poor.

Uniform

All students are expected to attend classes in the correct IDA uniform with appropriate footwear and hair neatly secured.

Uniform requirements are in place to ensure students can participate safely and present a professional appearance.

Behaviour & Conduct

Students, parents, and guardians are expected to behave respectfully toward staff, students, visitors, and other members of the IDA community at all times.

Bullying, aggressive behaviour, abusive language, discrimination, or anti-social conduct will not be tolerated.

Inspire Dance Academy reserves the right to suspend or withdraw any student or parent account where behaviour is deemed inappropriate or breaches Academy policies.

Safeguarding

Inspire Dance Academy is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of all children and vulnerable adults.

All students, parents, guardians, and staff are expected to comply with the Academy's safeguarding procedures and policies at all times.

Any safeguarding concerns should be reported to the Designated Safeguarding Lead.

Photography & Video Consent

Photography and video permissions are obtained during the registration process.

By enrolling with Inspire Dance Academy, parents/guardians confirm that the permissions selected on the registration form are accurate and up to date.

Images or videos may be used for classwork, performances, social media, promotional materials, and marketing purposes in line with the permissions granted.

Communication & Social Media

All communication relating to classes, performances, schedules, and Academy updates will be communicated through official IDA channels.

Parents, guardians, and students are expected to engage respectfully online and uphold the values and reputation of Inspire Dance Academy.

Negative, inappropriate, or harmful online behaviour relating to the Academy, staff, or students may be treated as a breach of these Terms & Conditions and the Code of Conduct.

Personal Property

Students are responsible for their own belongings while attending classes and events.

Inspire Dance Academy cannot accept responsibility for loss, theft, or damage to personal items brought onto the premises.

Health & Safety

Parents/guardians must inform Inspire Dance Academy of any medical conditions, injuries, allergies, or additional needs that may affect a student's participation in class activities.

Students participate in classes at their own risk, and while every care is taken, Inspire Dance Academy cannot accept responsibility for injuries sustained during classes, rehearsals, performances, or events except where caused by negligence.

Class Cancellations

In the event that a class is cancelled by Inspire Dance Academy due to unforeseen circumstances, a makeup class will be offered where possible.

Makeup classes may take place on an alternative day or time depending on studio and teacher availability.

Refunds will not be issued for cancelled classes where a suitable alternative is provided.

Data Protection

Inspire Dance Academy is committed to protecting personal data and handling all information securely and responsibly.

Personal information collected during registration will only be used for purposes directly relating to the operation of the Academy, including class administration, safeguarding, communication, and emergency contact purposes.
