Hair: Please match everything to hair color, this includes ponytails, bobby pins and clips. Hair is to be slicked back into a bun on the crown of the dancer's head, with no bangs on the face. Using a hair donut is the most helpful way to achieve the perfect bun. If the dancer's hair is too short, pull the upper half into a pony. No nail polish is permitted unless it's nude, or french. No jewelry is permitted. The only earrings that the students may wear are studs.

Hair Accessory: Scrunchie around Bun
