SELECTION GUIDE: MANAGEMENT LABELS & INDUSTRY APPROVALS

In the Bos Sires catalog, each animal is assigned a designation and may also receive an endorsement to help buyers understand its background, adaptability, and genetic merit. These classifications make it easier for buyers to select cattle that align with their specific grazing systems, management goals, and breeding philosophies.

ENDORSMENT LABELS



Awarded to cattle bred with Jan Bonsma's principles of hormonal balance, structure, and efficiency. Bulls are masculine, cows feminine, ensuring fertility. Selection is judged by the Bonsma All Breeds Group administrators.



The Zietsman Approved stamp is awarded to high-fertility, low-input cattle selected for efficiency and adaptability. Johan Zietsman personally determines which cattle meet his rigorous standards.

MANAGEMENT LABELS



Cattle that excel in ultra high-density grazing, thriving under intense pressure with minimal inputs. Their resilience allows them to outperform in less demanding environments.



Cattle adapted to sparse, open rangelands, capable of traveling further for forage while maintaining condition. Their efficiency makes them ideal for low-input grazing systems.



Cattle with strong grazing instincts, efficiently utilizing forage in varied environments with minimal supplementation, making them ideal for forage-based operations.

Texas-raised and heat-tolerant, Colombo III embodies the strength and resilience of our historic horned Hereford line, which traces back to the early 1900s in the rugged Chihuahuan Desert of Mexico. Originating in Coahuila, this herd was selected for adaptability, thriving in harsh conditions with minimal inputs. In the 1960s, the herd was closed to focus on superior internal selection, and about 20 years ago, a large group of heifers and top-choice bulls were hand-selected from the entire herd in Mexico by the late Gerald Fry, a well-known grass genetic expert. These cattle were brought to Texas, where careful breeding and selection refined the Colombo line of horned Herefords in Cameron, TX.

Now located in Deep East Texas under Counter Culture Farms, Colombo III carries forward this legacy of hardy, old-school grass-based genetics. He represents generations of meticulous selection, proving his ability to thrive in diverse environments while maintaining the durability, efficiency, and quality that define our program.


