Greetings members, as July has finally arrived I want to put some of the mysteries and unknowns of annual membership renewal to rest. First, July is not the date for renewals, it is the beginning of early bird renewals! Early renewals helps the Post when it comes to various recognition from District, Department and National officers. The actual annual membership is from January 1<sup>st</sup> and lasts till December 31<sup>st</sup>, that being said, July is the first you can renew for the next year!

The Post currently changes out the security card in July and has used the renewal as motivation to get the new security card, however, that is not a department or national rule, merely a Post rule.

Some members have received notice from national that they will become delinquent at a certain time, that is merely a marketing tool to encourage early renewals! A membership only becomes delinquent if now renewed by January 1<sup>st</sup>.

I am in no way discouraging early renewal, it makes the Post look good! 100% renewal is always the goal to achieve by the end of December!

Additionally, new membership does not have to wait for any specific date, it just means their dues must be paid again for the next year, at \$42/yr, that is a small price to pay for all the benefits membership brings!

Paid Up For Life will make your membership so much easier, you never need to renew again, while it is a bit pricey for the younger members, it can be done via monthly installments. We were the type of brothers that would tear through the jungle or desert looking for the enemy while blasting AC/DC Highway to Hell on the boom box, until a landmine destroyed it. We used to heat our coffee up with C4. Now we are turning into nothing more than a memory. Brotherhood memories are some of the best memories a veteran has. 


