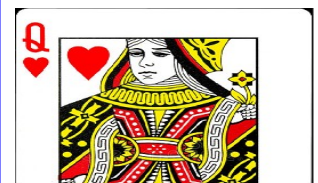

## From the Commander Airborne Beer

Every service has their legends on how things happened, here is a legend and the life of who made the legend reality about the Beer Run from the Siege of Bastogne and the Airborne Beer from WWII. In Belgium During the Siege of Bastogne in 1944 a 19-year-old machine gunner with the 501<sup>st</sup> Infantry Regiment, 101<sup>st</sup> Airborne Division from New York City named Vince Speranza went to visit a wounded friend in the field hospital set up in the burned-out town of Bastogne. Vince's friend told Vince that he wanted a drink. The only place Vince found was a tavern with a working beer tap, the only container that Vince had was his helmet, so he filled the helmet up with the beer that came from the tap and made it back to his friend, then other patients wanted some so he made more trips to and from the tavern. During one of his trips from the tavern Vince was caught by the Regimental surgeon who reprimanded him. During Vince's time in Europe during WWII Vince Speranza spent 144 days in combat everywhere from Bastogne, Battle of the Bulge, He helped liberate a concentration camp, then finally he made it to the Eagles Nest where he appropriated a couple books from Hitler's private library. Vince was in the 101<sup>st</sup> Airborne from 1943 to 1946 when he left the service with the rank of Private First Class. Vince did not return to Europe for many years after the war. In 2019 Vince Speranza was one of two veterans who participated in the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary to commemorate Operation Market Garden by parachuting into Belgium. During this tour of Belgium he was given a beer named Airborne Beer and it was served in a ceramic mug shaped like a helmet, and he was also told the legend about how the beer and mug came to be, little did the Belgians know they were talking to the legend until the moment he told them. I had a chance to meet Vince Speranza once during an Airborne Convention in Washington DC. One of the nicest people you would ever meet. Sadly, Vince Speranza died on August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023, at the age of 98 You can still see him on You tube just type in Vince Speranza and you will see everything from interviews to Vince singing Blood on The Risers He is a fascinating individual, he not only has a beer named after him but also a limited edition watch made in his honor.

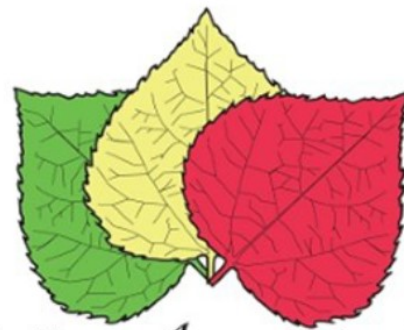
If you have not paid your 2025 membership dues you are now considered expired. Please get it paid ASAP and you will get your new door access card as well.

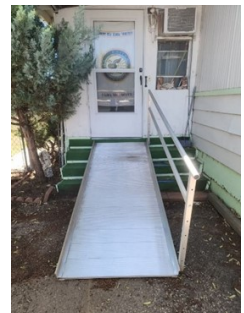
