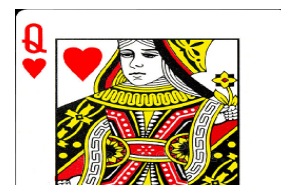

National made a mistake in sending out renewal notices earlier with the WRONG dues amount on them. Dues are \$52 NOT \$45. The increase is due to: Across the state a mandated increase effective immediately for 2027 votes & approved at Conference and at June's meeting Membership approved an additional \$2.00 raise to be effective for 2027 fiscal year to cover our District per capita increase voted on and approved last year. If you have already paid your dues, you could be getting a NEW RENEWAL form saying need to pay. You will just need to pay the difference of \$7.00. Once I get approval to start processing membership I will, that is why your check hasn't cleared and cards are not available yet. I'll be emailing/calling as well those that paid the \$45 not \$52 also. This is just one of small reasons to come to a meeting and have your voice heard. Please make sure your information is up to date.
