## MFPI BOARD RESOLUTION 7 SERIES OF 2022

### "GUIDELINES OF THE MEMBERSHIP AMNESTY PROGRAM, WAIVING ALL PAST ANNUAL DUES AND ALL NOTICES DEFERRED TO ALL VERIFIED MEMBERS OF THE MOUNTAINEERING FEDERATION OF THE PHILIPPINES FOR THE EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF A NATIONAL MEMBERSHIP DATABASE"

WHEREAS, *Article II Section I of the amended Articles of Incorporation of the Mountaineering Federation of the Philippines Incorporated (MFPI) that the corporate powers of the federation shall be exercised, its business conducted and its property controlled by the Board of Trustees.*

WHEREAS, *Article IV Section IV of the amended Articles of Incorporation of the Mountaineering Federation of the Philippines Incorporated (MFPI) that the qualifications and requirements for membership shall be determined by the Board of Directors.*

WHEREAS, *ARTICLE VI Section I of the amended Articles of Incorporation of the Mountaineering Federation of the Philippines Incorporated (MFPI) that the funds of the federation shall be derived from admission fees, annual dues and special assessment of members, gifts, donations and benefits.*

WHEREAS, *ARTICLE V of the amended Articles of Incorporation of the Mountaineering Federation of the Philippines Incorporated (MFPI) that if any member in default in payment of dues shall be suspended from all privileges of membership and if, after notice the default be not cured within the period of ninety (90) days, the membership of the member shall automatically cease and terminate.*

WHEREAS, *ARTICLE VI Section II of the amended Articles of Incorporation of the Mountaineering Federation of the Philippines Incorporated (MFPI) that every member of the federation shall in addition of the membership fee, pay dues and/or assessments that may be imposed by the federation from time to time.*

WHEREAS, *that the core of this organization is its members, that this institution thrived for forty-three (43) years and even survived through covid thru the support of loyal members and supporters.*

WHEREAS, *that the creation of a National Membership Database is essential to effectively monitor all the membership status of verified members of the federation.*

WHEREAS, *to encourage all regular and club members to renew their membership a membership amnesty program must be implemented which will waive all past annual dues and deferring all notices.*

WHEREAS, *to further encourage the members to apply for the amnesty program the color and the design of the logo of the federation is altered for the embroidery of a cloth patch which will be given free to the members who has successfully renewed their membership. 1 (one) complimentary federation cloth patch will be given per Club Member and the Regular Member may opt to buy the patch on a discounted price.*

WHEREAS, *to effectively implement the amnesty program these guidelines are hereby recommended.*

- I. To register to the national membership database every member must fill up this form in the website. <https://mfpi.org/>
- II. This shall apply to all Regular and Club members only.
- III. Fees will be monitored or collected by the Regional Vice Presidents and/or appointed members of the Education or Membership Committee in their respective area.
- IV. Registration period is from August 8 to October 31 2022 only.
- V. The President/Secretary of the affiliated clubs may register the names of their members to the National Membership Database.
- VI. Annual Dues  
Club Member – P2,000/club member  
Regular Member – P200/member
- VII. All Regional Vice Presidents must submit a financial statement for the fiscal year of 2022 included the collected fees generated from this resolution to the National Treasurer of the Federation.
- VIII. MFPI ID – P200 this is mandatory for Regular Members and optional for Club Members (\*ID design, annexed). The Federation ID will expire on December 31 2023
- IX. Members which its membership was resigned, revoked or terminated by a final decision of the past board of trustees and the majority of the federation are excluded from this amnesty program.
- X. The National Board of Trustees along with the members of the Membership, Education and Executive Committees has right to reject the registration of any member if and when warranted under the circumstances in the interest of the general membership.

WHEREAS, *the National Board of Trustees along with the members of the Membership, Education and Executive Committees will be reviewing all of the status of members that is registered into the database. Their recommendation will be final and executory.*

WHEREAS, *members who will be availing the membership amnesty program the fees paid will cover for the annual dues for the fiscal year 2022 and 2023.*

NOW, THEREFORE, *on the joint motion unanimously **APPROVED.***

RESOLVED, *that immediate implementation of an amnesty program waiving all past annual dues and deferring all notices is a prerequisite to effectively record all the status of the members of the federation, that the guidelines of the amnesty program is adopted, that the recommendation of the National Board of Trustees and the Joint Committees will be final and executory, that the distribution of the federation cloth patch is an effective way to display gratitude to the loyal members of the federation which has supported this organization and for the members who will be availing the membership amnesty program the fees paid will cover for the annual dues of the fiscal year 2022 and 2023.*

RESOLVED FURTHER, *that this resolution forwarded to Vice President for Visayas Randy Su, Vice President for Mindanao Restie Torres and Public Relations Officer Ken Vibar and all concerned, for their information and appropriate action.*
