2025 Flowery Branch Farmers Market Policy

Market Seasons and Hours:

- **Summer Market:** Every Thursday, May through October, from 3:30 PM to 6:30 PM. (rain or shine)
- Winter Market: November through April, on the 2nd and 4th Thursdays from 3:30 PM to 6:30 PM.(rain or shine) November and December could be altered based on holidays.
- Location: Market Pavilion, 5210 Railroad Ave, Flowery Branch, GA 30542.

Licensed Products: Vendors must provide a copy of current licenses for certain products, including:

- Dairy Products (Georgia Dairy Law)
- **Eggs** (Georgia Egg Law)
- Low Acid/Acidified Foods (Canned Vegetables, Pickles, Salsa, etc.)
- Meat Products (Georgia Meat Compliance Laws)
- Organic Products (must include certification)
- **Plants** (Live Plant License)
- Health Inspections, Permits & Catering Licenses:

All food trucks and food vendors must provide a copy of their most recent health inspection report, all required permits, and a valid catering license (if applicable) before participating in the market. Failure to submit these documents may result in denial of participation.

Permitted Products:

- **Raw Agricultural Products:** Produce, nuts, eggs, honey, milk, uncooked meat and seafood. Preference for local farm production.
- Fresh Cut Flowers and Plants: Live plants, herbs, seedlings.
- Ready-to-Eat Foods: For immediate consumption.
- **Prepared Foods:** Including baked goods, cheese, candy, confections, canned/preserved goods (must be packaged and labeled per Georgia Food Code).
- Locally Made Crafts: Handmade crafts by local artisans

• Health Inspections & Permits:

All food trucks and food vendors must provide a copy of their most recent health inspection report and all required permits before participating in the market. Failure to submit these documents may result in denial of participation.

Prohibited Products:

- No services (insurance, tutoring, real estate, etc.), weapons, or political/social causes.
- No non-local reselling of pre-packaged items or non-profit bake sales.
- No t-shirts or other clothing items may be sold unless approved by the market manager.

Market Fees:

- **\$125** per space for the season. **\$250** for double-booth space (subject to availability). Booth space cannot be shared or leased.
- Vendors must provide their own **tent**, **tables**, **chairs**, **canopy weights**, **display signs**, and **trash bags**. A canopy must be properly weighted with all four legs or vendors may be asked to leave.
- 8ft tents can only be used under Pavilion unless approved by market manager
- 10ft tents will be placed on lawn or on Railroad
- No refunds for missed markets.

Vendor Rules:

- **Product Exclusivity:** No guarantees for exclusivity. Only a limited number of vendors may sell certain products.
- **No Reselling:** Vendors can only sell items they have grown or made themselves, not resell from other markets or farmers.
- Winter and Summer Hours: Summer Market: Thursdays, 3:30 PM to 6:30 PM (Rain or Shine). Winter Market: 2nd and 4th Thursdays (Rain or Shine).
- **Labeling:** All processed products must have proper labeling, including ingredients, producer information, and health department approvals.
- **Kitchen Requirements:** Baked goods must be made in an inspected kitchen (commercial or shared) or have a valid cottage license.

- **Fire Safety:** Cooking with an open flame requires a fire extinguisher.
- Organic Certification: Organic products must show state certification.
- Market Inspections: Market management may inspect product sites at any time.

Booth and Location:

- The location of your booth is not guaranteed and cannot be changed upon request.
- Vendors are expected to stay in their assigned booth and be present for the full duration of the market (until 6:30 PM)
- Early breakdowns will not be allowed.

Absences:

- Vendors must communicate **absences 24 hours in advance**. Excessive absences or **no-shows** will result in the vendor being **removed from the market**. Vendors who do not show up without prior notice will no longer be allowed to participate in future markets.
- Absences must be communicated by Wednesday at 4:00 PM.

Vendor Conduct:

- Vendors must maintain **professional conduct** and are encouraged to be friendly, courteous, and honest.
- **No smoking**, alcohol, drug use, or profanity is allowed. Vendors may be subject to background checks.
- Market management reserves the right to expel any vendor for non-compliance with these rules.

Liability:

• The Flowery Branch Farmers Market and the City of Flowery Branch are **not responsible** for any damages, injuries, or losses that may occur.
