On 9-14-06 Evidence Technician Don Spera, of the Warrensville Hts. Police Department, processed a grey Ford Escort, lic. pl. DTL-1597 for latent prints. There were nine white powder latent prints recovered, internal report number 06-2838. On 9-14-06 the above latent prints were entered and searched in the Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) with no identification made at that time. Evidence Technician Don Spera, requested the above latent prints be compared to known suspects Sharon Dockery, S.O.# 223004, and Harry Briscoe, S.O.# 200711. The results of these comparisons are as follows: Found TWO (2) partial latent prints to be IDENTICAL to the fingerprint chart bearing the name of Harry Briscoe, S.O.# 200711.
