## Maxx Systems hackathon app tries to save your diet and ends up saving a life!

During a Maxx Systems App competition in which developers competed to create cool apps for Maxx's "smart fridge", Salvadore Cohantz wanted to win the prize by developing something that keeps you on your diet. It uses advanced body shape detection software to know when dieters are taking snacks from the fridge when they aren't supposed (for example, when Mom is not home from work yet) and sound an alarm or yell "step away from the fridge!" in a deep voice.
