Karen Utech has "Golden Moments" in the MOWA membership show. This runs through January 7th. She will also be participating in the Cedarburg Holiday Art Fair Dec. 8-10th. Additional artworks of hers can be seen at the Art Lounge in Menomonee Falls.

Renee Couture has three pastels on display at the Oconomowoc Fine Arts Center with the Waukesha Creative Arts League's Member Exhibit. They will be up until Jan. 14th during Box Office hours and 90 minutes before any performances there.

She also has 3 pieces on display at the Greenfield Library with the Wisconsin Pastel Artists which will be up until Jan. 5th. 
