Nohl Suitcase Export Fund, Student Silver ADDY and Fredric R. Layton Foundations Scholarship awards. She will be speaking on "The Healing Power of Art".

A Gentle Reminder – Call for Art for "Resilience and Renewal" Exhibit at Ovation Chai Point: We are pleased to announce that the CEO of Ovation (Chai Point) where our show will take place is generously sponsoring gift certificate prizes for our show as follows:

Best of Show - \$125

First Place - \$100

Second Place - \$75

Third Place – \$50

Honorable Mention – \$25

Remember, the size limitation for this small works exhibit is 14" high and 16" wide (including the frame). All works should be properly framed and wired. In

the case of deep cradled canvases and boards, they must be neatly finished on the edges. Sculpture can be of a significant size because of available floor space.

Please provide your contact information along with the details of your piece (including price) in your submission form as Ovation – who will not be taking any commission from sold works – will provide this on the labels that they create next to your art. Drop off is at Ovation to their art consultant Randy Crosby and artists will be informed when and how to do so in their acceptance notification.

Your submissions should be received by LMA at the latest at midnight on March 15, 2022 with no exceptions. The show will be exhibited from May 1 - June 30, 2022. When it is deemed safe, there will be a reception hosted by Ovation.

Beginning March 1 in-person school and other tours will resume. Hurrah! Another new exhibition will be on view, an exhibition of landscape photography will open in mid-March and April 7 to 10, the galleries will be fragrant with the return of <u>Art in Bloom</u>.

- Don't miss seeing the work of young artists in the <u>2022 Scholastic Art Awards: Wisconsin</u> <u>Exhibition</u>. The exhibition ends on March 20. You will be enthralled with the thoughtful work and the teenagers' impressive skills.
