

Ken also chaired the Sovie Jewry Committee of the Jewish Community Relations Council (JCRC), was a Founding Trustee of the Soviet Jewry Legal Advocacy Center. He had been an active Trustee of Facing History and Ourselves.

Ken has a long involvement with the JCRC, ultimately serving its President. He remains passionate about its work to engage the Jewish community in tikkun olam and the pursuit of social justice. He is a four and is Co-Chair of the Massachusetts Coalition to Save Darfur.

Ken is married to Dr. Gerri L. Sweder, psychologist at Gann Academy. They have two grown children and an expanding family.
