
^{**} Community Connections - To support emergency homeless there are reduced day services which will operate by phone from 9-5 on 29th 30th and 31st December. There will be support for those with no means of accessing phones through 1st Stop on these days from 9-5 but those presenting will be given an appointment time to return to receive a service. The Council's Out of Hours service operate outside these times, If you have a social care related emergency outside of normal working hours please call the Plymouth Out of Hours Service on 01752 346984. Dec 20th – 24th open as normal.

Plymouth City Council is once again working with **Plymouth Energy Community (PEC)** to offer lower income households support with their energy costs this winter.

If your charity/cause/organisation is working with a Plymouth household which would benefit from this assistance please read through the eligibility details below and use the referral form* to request help (*attached to the Newsletter email)

Now open for referrals. Applications close on 20th March 2022 or before if all funds are allocated. Please send the form to hsf@plymouthenergycommunity.com

Guidance - applications are by referral only. If you have staff eligible for support, please ask the person's line manager to complete and sign the form on their behalf. Grants may take up to 15 working days to administer. We will inform you and the resident of grants awarded.





ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE

- **GRANTS** £245 for families with children and £147 for other eligible households. These are either paid directly to energy suppliers if on a credit meter, or via fuel vouchers for prepayment meter customers. See application form for definition of 'family'.
- **REPAIRS** to heating and hot water systems. These are conducted by local, framework contractors known to PEC.
- WHITE GOODS these can be requested only if broken, or wholly absent and considered essential.

ELIGIBILITY - Resident location - only open to residents who are liable to pay Council Tax to Plymouth City Council. Students may send a copy of their tenancy agreement.

Income – household income must be under £30k net once housing and energy costs are met, or the resident is in receipt of qualifying benefits (see application form). Please tell us of any special circumstances if applicants fall outside of this criteria.

EVIDENCE OF IDENTITY- If the resident is known to you and you have seen their photographic ID, please digitally sign the form.

If the resident is not a client of yours, please send a copy of one of the following – passport, driving licence, birth certificate, residency card or citizen card. We will verify the bill payer's given address against Council Tax records.
