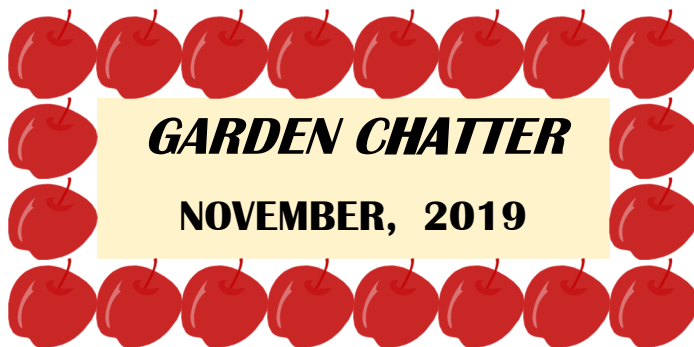

NOVEMBER CRAFT IDEA

Make the Centerpiece: Coat roughly 14 [cobs of dried corn](#) with metallic gold and copper [spray paint](#). Once dry, hot-glue cobs to the perimeter of a 6-inch round vase. Tie it all together with [gold raffia](#). Fill vase with [floral foam](#) and add seasonal flowers as desired. (This sampling includes dahlias, zinnias, and mountain ash berries.)

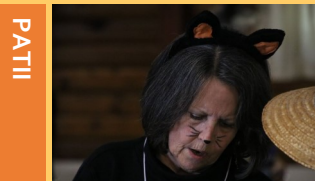

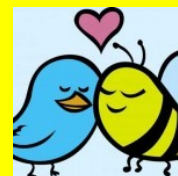

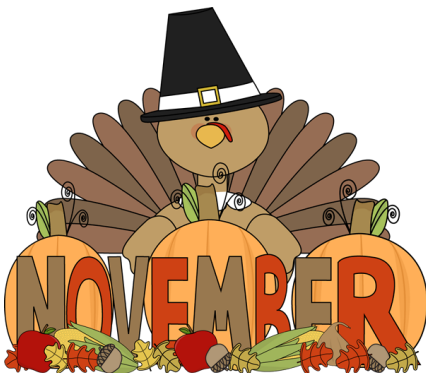
