## Required Safety Procedures in Place Per Surgeon General

The next several weeks are critical that we practice and implement our safety procedures. Governor DeSantis announced he is issuing an Executive Order to direct Florida's Surgeon General, Dr. Rivkees, to issue a public health advisory urging the following:

- Persons 65 years or older are encouraged to stay home for 14 days;
- Persons with certain underlying medical conditions are encouraged to stay home for 14 days;
- All employers are encouraged to utilize telework; and
- Consistent with CDC guidance, all individuals should avoid social gatherings of 10 or more.
