

To the Members of the International Court Council and All Whom This May Concern,

It is with great pride, and an unwavering sense of conviction that I offer my wholehearted endorsement to Empress Sabrina H. Seville for the position of Queen Mother 2 of the Americas.

When I stepped into my role as Empress of Regina, it was Sabrina who was the first to welcome me. She curtsied, addressed me as Your Majesty, and drew me into the sisterhood of Empresses with a grace and warmth I will never forget. And then, almost in the same breath, she looked at me and said: "What can I do to help?"

That is Sabrina. That is the whole of her, right there in five words.

She is a Baba in the truest sense — someone who does not simply offer support but gets in there alongside you and matches every word with a deed and usually with a bag of onions to chop alongside you. In a world where titles can sometimes outpace action, Sabrina has spent thirty years making sure her actions speak loudest. Thirty years of service to the Imperial Court System, over two decades as a Monarch, and a distinguished place within the International Court Council. Her record is extraordinary. But it is that instinct — to show up, to ask how she can help, and then to actually help — that sets her apart.

I write to you also as the voice of a region that is too often overlooked in conversations at the ICC level. The Prairie Courts of Canada have long been underrepresented in the larger discourse of our international family. We are communities that have built something remarkable with deep roots, fierce loyalty, and incredible heart — and yet our voices do not always carry to the rooms where decisions are made.

Sabrina H. Seville is one of the very few Heirs in our system who has maintained true relevance and visibility within the Prairie Courts while simultaneously holding a meaningful place within the ICC. She has not forgotten where she comes from. She has used her platform to amplify our region rather than leave it behind, and that matters enormously to those of us who call the Canadian Prairies home.

Sabrina is, by every measure, the most progressive candidate in this race. Her values — her commitment to inclusion, to activism, to ensuring every member of our community is embraced fully and without condition — are a direct reflection of what we stand for here on the Canadian Prairies. She does not simply speak these values. She has lived them, deed by deed, for three decades.

The title of Queen Mother 2 of the Americas deserves someone who will carry it with wisdom, warmth, and a genuine understanding of the full breadth of our community — not just its most visible centres, but its prairies, its smaller courts, its people who have given everything to this system and deserve to be seen in return.

That person is Sabrina. Our Baba. Someone who will look at this entire community and ask, with complete sincerity: "What can I do to help?"

I urge every court, every noble, and every courtier who has ever felt that the Prairie voice deserves a seat at the table to stand with us in supporting her candidacy.
