# Responses Received Last Week

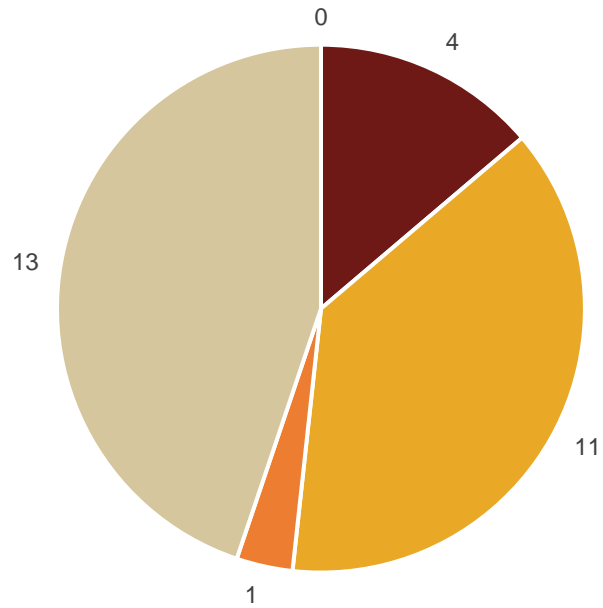
How can you make sure these plans build upon and enhance Africatown's strengths, assets, and neighborhood character?

- “All plans need funding. We have to look outside of Mobile if the funds cannot be committed from within.”



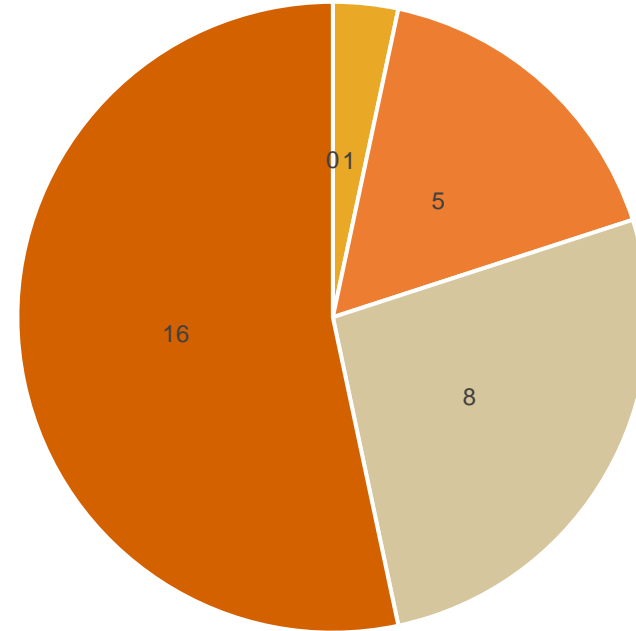

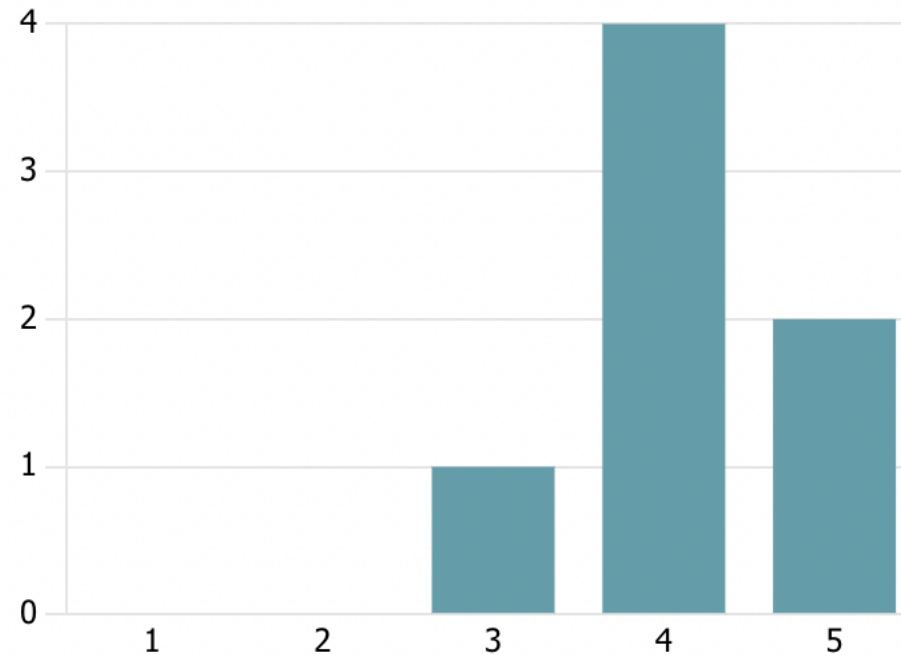
