The San Antonio Chapter of Blacks in Government is accepting applications for the Annual Hazel and William Hays Scholarship; Raymond Beebe Scholarship; and the Sherry Blake Memorial Scholarship for College or Trade/Vocational School.

The grant/scholarship is designed for graduating High School Seniors in the San Antonio and surrounding areas who desire to attend an accredited institution of higher learning. The chapter will award up to three grants/scholarships in the amount of **\$1,000.00 each. The awards are not renewable. The High School Senior is only eligible to receive one of the three grants/scholarships.**

Application Deadline: 4 May 2024

Please note that applicants are only eligible to receive one grant/scholarship listed above.

All applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Graduating senior in high school/trade/vocational school with a GPA of at least a **3.0** on a **4.0** scale.
- List any academic and community achievements and awards to present date.
- List career goals and aspirations
- **Two** letters of recommendation from school and **one** letter of recommendation from a community leader (Pastor, organizational leader, etc.) are required.

Application Deadline:

Application and supporting documents must be postmarked no later than **4 May 2024**. Applications will NOT be accepted if not completed in its entirety.

Selection Process:

The BIG Scholarship Committee will review applications, determine awardee(s), and submit recommendations to the Chapter's Executive Board for approval.

Fund Distribution:

Awardees will be notified by **May 24, 2024**. Funds will be presented to the student at the BIG Scholarship Banquet on **Saturday, July 27, 2024**. More information will follow.

Procedure for Application Process:

1. Attach the following documents to your completed application:
 - Official High School transcripts
 - Verification of potential enrollment at an accredited institution of higher learning, if available
 - Letters of recommendation as stated above
