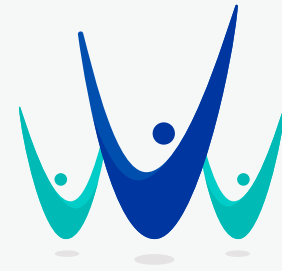


Albert Arthur brings over 20 years of extensive experience in fisheries, both nationally and internationally, encompassing fisheries biology, management, and sustainability.
