- · Vendors are expected, rain or shine! Please prepare properly, and provide sun cover. There are no refunds!
- Vendors must provide table and chairs, maintain an attractive space during event hours, and clean up their space
 after the event closes, including sweeping debris and removing garbage from their space to designated areas.
 Any Vendor leaving garbage, and/or not maintaining their rented space will not be welcomed to return.
- Food Vendors (including sampling) must obtain and display a Schenectady County Health Dept. permit, at their own expense.
