## **OPEN FLOOR**

### **Supplier's Presentations**

President Jody Pratt had asked the suppliers to deliver a short presentation on their products or services.

- Brad Doucette, owner of Atlantic Sani Sport spoke about his company's sanitizing services for equipment such as first aid equipment, firefighting PPE and sporting equipment to eliminate bacteria, carcinogens and bloodborne pathogens by using ozone and steam up to 120C. Members asked questions relating to pricing and turnaround time.
- Justin Neate from MicMac Fire & Safety Source had a great product discussion about the change in NFPA standards that will affect firefighter PPE and SCBA. Stored energy and compression burns were discussed in a concise manner. Differences in bunker gear that is already prepared for proposed standards changes were demonstrated.
- Both reps were thanked for taking the time to educate our members about their products and services. We hope to see more suppliers that are willing to share more of their expertise with the membership.

### **Letter Submission**

Chief Denis Pleau submitted a letter to the SEFFA Executive to voice his opinion and concerns about the Province's Training Standards Advisory Committee and the importance of its re-instatement. This letter was submitted directly to NBAFC President Chief Raymond LeBlanc who was in attendance to take the matter to the next NBAFC meeting. President Jody Pratt thanked Chief Denis Pleau for his time and effort in addressing the issue.
