NBCC/NBAFC are working together to make Level 1 and Level 2 available online this making it more accessible to people who have work/time commitments, practice requirements would stay the same as they are now.

NBAFC is looking into the possible purchase of a Live Burn Trailer, Jody Price and a couple members from the Capital Association, there are several types of Burn trailers and can cost upwards of \$500,000

Level 1 and 2 Fire Investigation Courses have been completed, with 25 successfully completing Level 1 and 22 successfully completing Level 2
