To: Lake Arrowhead Water System Customers

Re: Water Mainline Replacement

Dear Lake Arrowhead Customers,

Spring means that it is construction season once again. The PUD intends to complete the final phase of the Lake Arrowhead water system rebuild in 2025. Construction to complete the mainline replacement will resume in June. The new contractor for this project is Rognlin's Inc.

Rognlin's is slated to mobilize in the week of June 8th for their preliminary work. Mainline construction will begin the week of June 16th and continue through mid-September. The goal is to have this project fully completed by the end of September. Please keep in mind there may be unforeseen occurrences that come up that could potentially extend the completion timeline, but the goal is to be done by the end of September.

To recap this project, we are replacing the old system with new materials, like-for-like. In other words, new pipes replace old pipes, with newer material that will withstand the groundwater influence and soil conditions. Your drinking water is not affected by this project. The water system is approved for 400 connections and there are currently 194 remaining connections. This project is not adding or taking away from our approved connections. Anyone interested in a water connection can call the water department to find out the fees associated with obtaining a new connection or reconnecting to the system.

Last year the PUD crew installed a new mainline along W. Satsop Cloquallum Rd. This year the PUD crew will install the last portion of new main on W. Hamma Hamma Dr. **Our crew is scheduled to mobilize on site the week of May 12th** and have this mainline completed by the end of July, weather dependent. There may be times when the PUD crew is not on site due to inclement weather or other water emergencies on our other systems.

Once again, thank you for your patience and accommodation during the disruptive work around your homes. Once all work is completed for the overall mainline replacement, an updated letter will be sent out. Please don't hesitate to reach out to me with any questions.
