

The Beginnings Of A Community Advocate:

"A key moment in 11th grade when $m\gamma$ teacher, Miss Tate, recognized $m\gamma$ potential despite my academic struggles. *Her acknowledgment* of my ability to think critically and lead, despite my academic shortcomings, left an indelible mark on me. She probably was the only teacher that ever made me feel like I could learn something or I could be somebody."

My journey as a young adolescent began amidst complexity. My family's relocation to Miami during my formative years presented a starkly different environment from what I was accustomed to. Despite the initial challenges of adapting to this new setting, I found myself making choices that veered my life off course, choices I knew were unwise but pursued nonetheless.

As I recount these experiences, I'm reminded of meeting my wife in her teenage years, a unexpectedly fortunate encounter that shaped our shared journey. We founded a family despite my motherin-law's opposition. Years later, she recognized our hard work. Our commitment to giving back to our community became a cornerstone of our success in life.

When I was starting a small organization, one person in the group advised me to dress more professionally (I was a street guy and I wasn't a dressy person wearing suits). I was fortunate enough to meet the owner of Suited for Success located in Overtown, she invited me to visit the organization, and they fitted me for my first suit jacket, It was a humbling experience. I felt that I was doing great things in the community, so I wanted to dress according to the occasion. Miss Sonia the director of Suited for Success not only gave me the first suit jacket I ever owned in my life, but also she helped build my confidence as well because when I used to go to those meetings I was very different from everyone else.

Having a strong support system has been instrumental in my life's journey. It's inspired me to dedicate myself to helping others. As the director of Neighbors and Neighbors Association (N.A.N.A.), The Black Economic Development Coalition (Tools for Change), and the Lead Organizer of the Circle of Brotherhood, I'm fortunate to be part of organizations that are making a real difference in our community.

How To Apply <u>Neighbors & Neighbors Association (NANA)</u>

If you are already in business you can apply in **Miami-Dade County** to the "**Mom and Pop Small Business Grant Program**" available every year in all 13 County Commission Districts. You can apply usually around the beginning of every year in January, February and March. The application in each district is different so make sure you are applying in the right district (call 311 to find your District), and follow the right guidelines. This program was created by Neighbors and Neighbors Association (N.A.N.A.) on behalf of a former County Commissioner Barbara Kery Schuler, supported the first funding for the program, and now it is an official government program that's offered every year

If you're looking for small grants or small loans you can always reach out to our office. Yu can also go to the Miami–Dade County website to find more opportunities created for small businesses as well as the other programs.

True Heroes Finding Hope in Grief


EVERY DAY, 17 PEOPLE DIE WAITING FOR AN ORGAN TRANSPLANT

11 years ago, while tirelessly **working in the community to prevent gun violence and advocating for its cessation**, my 19–year–old son fell victim to gun violence. In the aftermath of this personal tragedy, my wife and I sought solace in altruism. Aware of our son's aspirations in his youth, including discussions about organ donation, my wife initiated a conversation with me about the possibility of honoring his wish to donate his organs to those in need.

Despite initial reservations rooted in cultural norms, we decided to fulfill our son's desire, ultimately **saving lives** and forging connections with the recipients. Meeting the recipient of our son's heart, a white non–Hispanic male, prompted reflection on racial perceptions. However, our dialogue with him and his family proved enlightening, showcasing the transformative power of empathy and understanding across racial divides.

I pondered how the recipient felt about receiving an organ from a person of color, knowing they were not of the same race. While the urgency of a life-threatening situation diminishes concerns about such matters.

I told my wife that this experience could lead to one of two outcomes: either it would alter the recipient's perspective, fostering acceptance and understanding towards people of color, or it would reaffirm their already compassionate nature.



By extending their life, the recipient might now see beyond racial differences, finding hope and unity despite receiving organs from someone of a different race.

This seemingly small yet profound gesture has the potential to contribute to a more inclusive society, even for those grappling with prejudices

I recently discussed this with my wife, the organ recipient of my son's heart, and his spouse. This conversation stemmed from genuine introspection regarding the recipient's character and their attitude toward accepting a heart from a black individual. It evolved into a beautiful exchange. 104, 594 Americans need an organ transplant...*





Wealth Begins Within: Cultivating a Prosperous Mindset

Learn More About Neuroscience and Entrepreneurship Research



Numerous studies in neuroscience offer guidelines for generating positive change. However, the origin of thought, that essence that unites mind, will, and emotions, remains a mystery. It is that spirit that gives value to our experiences and gives us the ability to choose between good and evil. Consciousness is the space where we can evaluate the importance of internal and external stimuli that drive our actions.

Consciousness, Will, And Impulses

The ability to know our environment and ourselves requires a clear and objective view of reality. Consciousness is that "inner voice" that guides us, evaluating situations but not imposing decisions. Will, on the other hand, is the faculty of making conscious and rational decisions. Our brain is designed to analyze, reflect, and judge, allowing us to make decisions that help us adapt to our environment successfully.




Rewrite Your Story, No Matter Your Age, Anytime, Anywhere!

Our attitude towards our thoughts and emotions significantly influences how we perceive ourselves and how we relate to others. Knowing our emotions and analyzing our thoughts allows us to eliminate those that harm us. It is essential to recognize the importance of affirming, renewing, or changing our thoughts to improve our quality of life. Neuroplasticity is the response to change and adapt our brain's structure and function throughout life.

Knowledge about our strengths, values, and skills is developed through "tacit knowledge," the "know-how" gained through practice and intuition, rather than formal learning (for example, a mechanic has the know-how to fix a car).

The verb "to be" expresses permanent characteristics or inherent qualities. For example: "I am happy because I am optimistic." Here, "being optimistic" is a permanent characteristic. In contrast saying "I am happy because I won the lottery" expresses a temporary feeling caused by a specific event.

The "When" and "Because" conditionals can significantly impact our self-awareness. Recognizing the difference between permanent qualities and temporary states can help us navigate our emotions and make better decisions.





Informed and rational choices allows us to pause and reflect before reacting impulsively.

Making informed decisions allows us to develop the necessary skills to face the challenges that arise in our interactions with others. Happiness, in addition to being an end in itself, helps us save time, energy, and resources.

Life is full of ups and downs. Intelligence is not limited to the amount of knowledge, but to the ability to learn, understand, and apply ideas. Knowing how to process information helps us solve problems effectively, avoiding impulsive reactions.

Overcoming Challenges




