

Are you a registered member of your parish?

If you are not registered or if you are not sure if you are registered, please contact the Pastor. Registration forms can be found on the church website, in the church office or in the vestibule of the church.

Why should you register? When you register you declare your desire to be part of a Catholic faith community. It also affects census number and possible benefits and obligations from the Diocese. Registered members can also expect pastoral care from their parish including baptisms, anointing of the sick and funerals.

Did you know... You must be a registered member of a parish to receive a Catholic wedding. Also, once children turn 18 they should register with their parish as an adult independent of their parents.

Notes from Fr. Vincent:

The commemoration of all the faithful departed

"If Job's sons were purified by their father's sacrifice (Job 1/5), why would we doubt that our offerings for the dead bring them some consolation? Let us not hesitate those who have died and to offer our prayers for them"

(St. Chrysostom)

Today's celebration of All Souls is more a feast of hope than a day of mourning for the dead. By visiting the graves of our beloved ones and praying for all who have died, we profess and affirm our faith that we are still linked with the dead, that for us they are not gone forever but that we shall see them again in the home of our Father in heaven. For them and for us the stone of the tomb will be rolled away, and we will rise from death as once Jesus raised Lazarus and he himself rose from the tomb. Let us celebrate this resurrection faith today.

Today begins the vocation awareness week. Vocation Awareness Week invites us to listen deeply to the voice of God who calls each of us by name. A vocation is not only for priests or religious—it is God's personal plan of love for every heart. Some are called to serve at the altar, others to witness through marriage, consecrated life, or single life. What matters most is our faithful "yes" to the Lord. Like Mary who said, "Be it done unto me according to your word," we are invited to trust that God's call will lead us to true joy and fulfillment. Let us pray for open hearts—to hear, to discern, and to courageously follow where the Good Shepherd leads.

Please pray that young people in today's culture will hear and respond to God's call. What do I do to encourage them to consider the priesthood and consecrated life?
