

#### **Notes from Fr. Vincent:**

#### Fourth Sunday of Advent

When asked why and how he could accomplish so much, St. Francis of Assisi replied: "This may be why: I think the Lord looked down from heaven upon the earth and said, "Where can I find the weakest, the littlest, the poorest man on the earth?" Then He saw me and said: "Now I have found him, and will work through him. He won't be proud of it. He will see that I am only using him because of his littleness and insignificance."

In today's Gospel, we enter the quiet drama of Joseph's heart. Matthew tells us not only about the birth of Jesus, but about the trust, obedience, and courage that make that birth possible within God's plan. Joseph discovers that Mary is with child, and although he does not yet understand, he chooses the path of mercy. He resolves to protect her from shame. Even before he knows the full story, Joseph's heart is already aligned with God's compassion.

Joseph teaches us that faith is often lived in the hidden, difficult moments where God invites us to trust more deeply than our understanding. Sometimes the Lord asks us to welcome what is mysterious, uncomfortable, or unexpected. And yet, like Joseph, when we open our hearts, God turns our fears into grace.

As we prepare for Christmas, let us ask for Joseph's virtues: a listening heart, a merciful spirit, and the courage to say "yes" when God speaks. Emmanuel comes to dwell with us—not only in Bethlehem, but in every heart that, like Joseph, chooses trust over fear and obedience over doubt.

I wish you all a very Happy Christmas.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, born in humble Bethlehem, be born anew in our hearts today and fill our lives with Your peace and saving love. Amen

## **Adult Education Notes**

Fellow parishioners, we are truly very close to our journey to the crib. Have we traveled with the Holy Family with great joy? Caryll Houselander a 20th century writer wrote this, "During this tender time of Advent, we must carry him (Jesus) in our hearts to wherever he wants to go, and there are many places to which he may never go unless we take him."

Consider these words for a moment. Has your Advent been one of a heart journey? Have you taken Jesus with you throughout your Advent toward Christmas? Have you tried to make these last three weeks a little more holy in your life? You have 4 days left. You can still make room for him or share him with others.

Every year, every Christmas, we are invited to wait with Mary and Joseph for the Messiah to come. When the Angel Gabriel came to Mary, he asked her to be the Mother of God. she said "yes", and then he left. He Just Left...She was 12-14 years old. She had no details, no instructions, no 'more of message to come'. Think about that....TRUST. So she waited. Taking one moment at a time, waiting and trusting in the God she worships. And she hopes.

She examples to us that when life throws unexpected circumstances our way and we have no clue what to do, we trust. God has this. His plan is better than ours but we have to trust in his way and his timing. The O Antiphons we pray these seven days before Christmas are prayers of hope. They introduce each Mass these days reminding us who the Messiah is. Each one opens with a Name of God reminding us Who is coming-Who we are waiting for-Who it is we are anticipating.

Find some time these last few days to be more silent. Look for the nudges of hope. Stay focused on the TRUE meaning of Christmas and the REAL reason WHY Jesus came as Messiah and Savior. It was because we sinned and God sent His Son to live as we do and bring us home to Heaven. What more can He do for us. What true love He brings. The gift of new life. Merry Christmas!
