



Are you in need of help with your gas and electric bills?

Seniors Assistance Center is an approved Community and Economic Development Association of Cook County (CEDA) partner intake site. Residents can apply for heating and electric assistance through LIHEAP.

Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) Program offers heating and electricity assistance to income-eligible households. A direct vendor payment (DVP) issues a one-time benefit applied directly to your utility account(s). Cash payments are also available to eligible households who do not have heating and electric bills because their energy costs are included in the rent. If you are in need of energy support or if you are in danger of utility disconnection or are currently disconnected, call for an appointment.
