Supervisor Nasca relayed the following:

There is one ongoing GA case and none pending.

Supervisor Nasca attended the Senior Center/Aging Care Connections Open House, which was well-attended by community members including the mayors of both Harwood Heights and Norridge.

The Township, in an effort to reduce costs, is currently in the process of changing phone and internet services.

A resident located on Redwood Dr. in the unincorporated section phoned to report a sink hole, which first emerged and was corrected in 2024, has reappeared. The water company has been contacted. They will be sending out the sewer foreman to investigate.

A resident in the unincorporated section emailed to report the streetlights are out again on Bryn Mawr Ave. between Prospect Ave. and Crescent Ave. Com-Ed has been contacted

The Township will be closed July 3 in observance of Fourth of July.
