### **Approval of Minutes from February 27, 2026, Town Board Meeting**

As the first order of business Supervisor Nasca entertained a motion to dispense with the reading of the February 27, 2026, Town Board meeting minutes and accept them as presented. Trustee Stefanowicz moved. Trustee Di Piero seconded the motion. Supervisor Nasca called for a voice vote. Motion unanimously carried.

### **Approval of Expenditures for Town Fund, Road & Bridge and General Assistance**

Trustee Wyda moved, seconded by Trustee Stefanowicz, to authorize the expenditures for the Town Fund, Road & Bridge and General Assistance. Supervisor Nasca called for a voice vote. Motion unanimously carried.

### **Public Comment:**

Cook County Sheriff Lieutenant Doyle addressed the Board sharing the Sheriff's Department plan for Distracted Driving Month which will be in April. The department will continue cycling through the community with the goal of reducing distracted driving.

### **Supervisor's Report:**

Supervisor Nasca relayed the following:

There is one ongoing GA case and none pending.

Supervisor Nasca and Assessor Karns attended the Glen Edens Homeowners Association's annual meeting on March 3 where they shared information on the township and an overview of real estate taxes with the residents. The Township was closed March 17 for Election Day. There was a steady flow of voters.

The Township will be participating in the April 25 Annual Community Kindness Day by collecting food donations to be distributed to local food pantries.

The Township Office will be closed Friday, April 3 for Staff Appreciation Day.

Supervisor Nasca has been coordinating with the Cook County Sheriff's Office to host an internet safety presentation held at the Township in April or early May.

The Township received a complaint from a resident in the unincorporated area regarding excessive debris in their neighbor's yard. The Township forwarded a Cook County Health Department complaint form to the resident who called.

Trustee Michael Ciszewski, of the Norwood Park Lighting District, submitted his resignation. The trustee position will be filled by the Cook County Board.

The Township is still in the process of developing an agreement with Special Needs Chicago, Inc. for the Wheelchair Accessible Transportation Voucher Program.

Ridgewood High School held their job fair on March 20 from 9:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.  
Eisenhower Library will be hosting their Annual Wellness Fair on May 9 from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.  
Harwood Heights FOP Lodge #172 will be hosting their 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Golf Outing on Monday, June 22 at White Pines Golf Club in Bensenville. There are opportunities for players and sponsorships.

**Committee Reports:**

Trustee Di Piero (Building Maintenance & Veterans Committee) stated he had nothing to report at this time.

Trustee Wyda (Senior Citizens & Disability Committee) reported that 0 cab books were sold in March.

Trustee Cichon (Youth Committee, Law and Ordinance) Supervisor Nasca reported on the Youth Committee Meeting held earlier in the evening where the committee discussed the grant request from the Norwood/Harwood Little League Program. The committee recommended tabling the grant request until more specific information could be gathered.

Trustee Stefanowicz (Finances) reported that the review of the monthly audit shows that everything is in order.
