Norwood Park Township is discussing the possibility of sponsoring Flu Shots for approximately \$8,000.00 in October. Supervisor Lupo will be discussing the possibility with the Norwood Park Fire Dept. Trustee Stefanowicz moved, Trustee Nasca seconded not to exceed \$10,000.00. Supervisor Lupo called for a voice vote. Motion unanimously carried.

Trustee Nasca reported a Youth Committee Meeting to discuss covering the Norwood Park Township Enrichment Camp fees. Trustee Alongi moved, Trustee Nasca seconded to approve \$10,000.00 and not to exceed that amount. Supervisor Lupo called for a voice vote. Motion unanimously carried.

Highway Commissioner's Report:

Commissioner Rogawski informed the Town Board that there was a significant storm that passed through the area. It downed several trees in the unincorporated area. Supervisor Lupo and I toured the area and assisted several residents with either clearing branches or providing contact info to tree contractors (one provided by Trustee Alongi), one we've used and third was our landscaper. Additionally COMED was notified when it was appropriate.

The amended budget meeting notice was sent to the Trib. The meeting will be at the end of July. This will facilitate the funding for completing the sewer project on Bryn Mawr.

There is a labor strike by the Local 150 Operators that is beginning to have an impact on many construction projects and probably will affect the sewer project as well. I have been in contact with the engineer and hopefully we can move forward anyway as the only real impact we might experience is a delay in the "backfilling" of the work after everything is installed.

Potholes have been filled and haven't had any calls for more work in that regard.
