**Supervisor's Report:**

Supervisor Nasca stated the following:

There is one ongoing GA case and none pending.

Community Kindness Day is April 26th. The food donations collected by the Township have been delivered to the Salvation Army.

The Card Making Class held at the Township on April 24<sup>th</sup> went very well.

This past month training for FOIA and OMA was completed via Zoom.

May 15<sup>th</sup> is the Senior Assistance Center's 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Bourbon and Wine Tasting Fundraiser.

Thursday, June 12<sup>th</sup> the Cook County Sheriff's Office will be presenting a safety workshop at the Township titled "Cryptocurrency Scams".

Tuesday August 5<sup>th</sup> is National Night Out. In the past to support this important community event the Township has contributed inflatables and face painters. Serving on the committee this year the supervisor has asked for anyone wishing to volunteer that evening to reach out to him.

**Committee Reports:**

Trustee Di Piero (Building Maintenance & Veterans Committee) stated everything is good regarding building maintenance.

He added that the Village of Norridge Memorial Day Service will be held on May 25<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 p.m.

Trustee Wyda (Senior Citizens & Disability Committee) reported 2 cab books were sold in the month of April. He also reported on the Senior Citizens Committee meeting that was held earlier in the evening. The committee voted to recommend a grant amount in the amount of \$1300 be given to the Golden Fellowship Club.

Trustee Stefanowicz (Finances) stated after reviewing the March 31<sup>st</sup> statements from the Town Fund, General Assistance and Road & Bridge the balance is better than the previous year.

**Assessor's Report:**

Assessor Karns stated that deadline for filing exemptions has passed but the Cook County Assessors website is still accepting online filings. Property assessment appeals can be filed through May 5<sup>th</sup>. His office in the last month has assisted residents with 167 exemption filings, 159 appeals and a few dozen Certificates of Error.


