### **Pvt Ezra Dupuis**

Pvt Ezra Dupuis was a member of the 308<sup>th</sup> trench mortar battery, 83<sup>rd</sup> INFANTRY DIVISION.

He was KIA by an exploding shell, on October 23, 1918, in Boisson Bois, France.

He is buried at Green Grove Cemetery in Ashland.

## **Sgt Horace A. Cross**

Sgt Horace A. Cross, was a member of the 454<sup>th</sup> AAF Bomb Group, 15<sup>th</sup> Air Force.

As an aerial gunner, assigned to b-24 bombers, he was KIA on November 20, 1944, by enemy forces,  
while parachuting from his disabled bomber over Silesia, Germany.

He made the ultimate sacrifice at the age of nineteen. He is buried at Green Grove Cemetery, in Ashland.

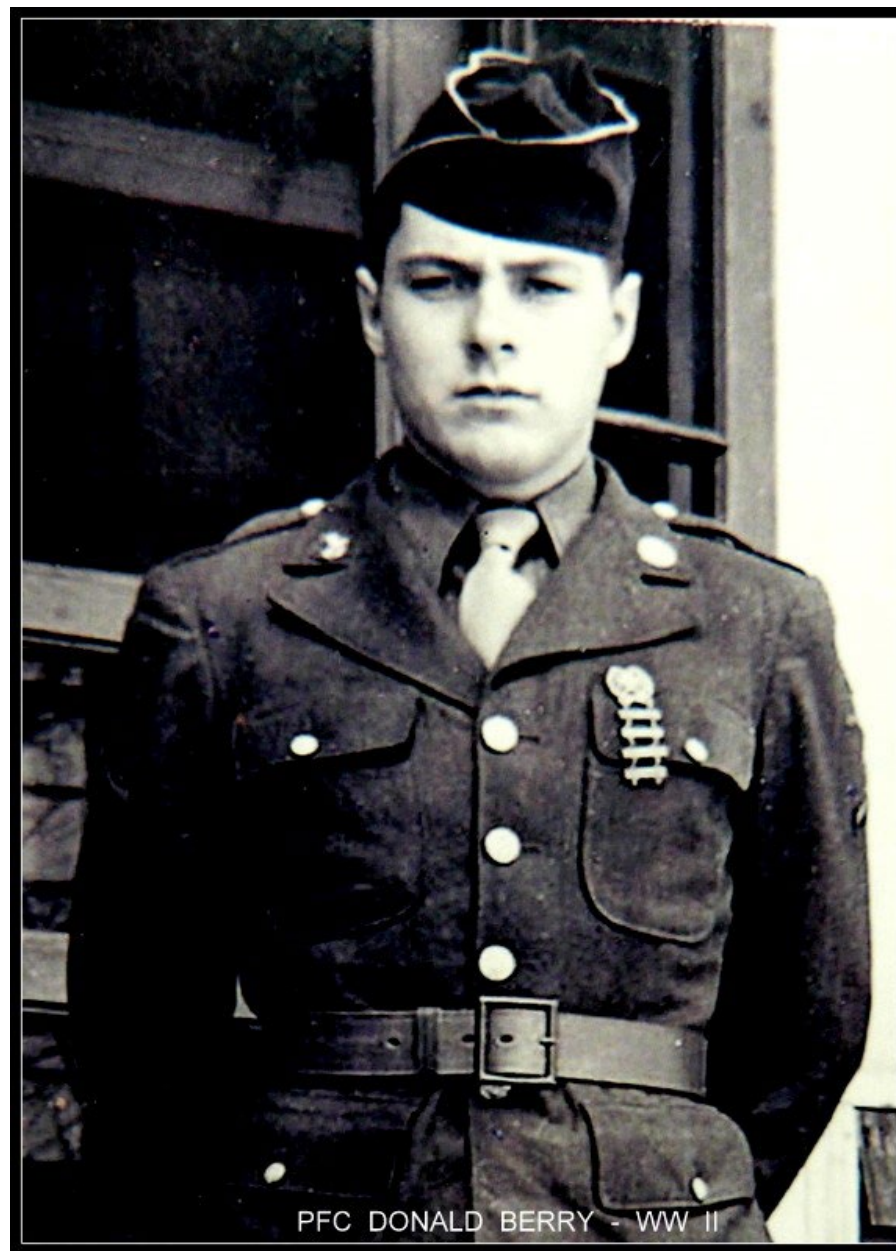

Cpl Frank L. Cass, was a member of the 8<sup>th</sup> Engineer Battalion, Cavalary Division.

He was KIA on March 11, 1971, by an explosive device, at Binh Duong Province, South Vietnam.

He made the ultimate sacrifice at the age of nineteen.

He is buried at Green Grove Cemetery, in Ashland.
