Invites applicants for: Firefighter (Intern)

The District:

The River Delta Fire District is approximately 50 square miles and is located near Highway 12 and Highway 160 near Rio Vista and Isleton, CA. The district runs approximately 400 calls per year and is staffed with Volunteer Firefighters who are required to dedicate one 24-hour shift per week. The district encompasses the Delta Loop, which meanders along the Mokelumne River, San Joaquin River and Seven Mile Slough. There are several boat harbors, restaurants, resorts and camp sites along the ten-mile stretch of the loop. The area is a major summer destination to thousands of recreators. The district serves a population of 1,500 residents and during the summer months, the population significantly increases up to 10,000 during busy weekends.

The Position:

Under general supervision, Firefighter Interns attend monthly drills at the fire station training grounds, participates in community events fire prevention activities, assists in the maintenance and care of station facilities, apparatus, and equipment, and performs all other duties as assigned by officers of the fire district. Firefighter Interns may participate in 24-hour shift ride-alongs with on-duty crews and perform the full array of duties including but not limited to fire suppression and emergency medical services depending on training level.

The Ideal Candidate:

The ideal candidate must be highly motivated. You are required to attend monthly drills, attend a one-two day orientation/academy and occasionally public/fire service events.

Qualifications:

Candidates must meet a combination of one the following:

- Must have completed an accredited Firefighter I Academy with a course completion certificate and as a condition of the position, must obtain a California State EMT certification within three years of start date.
- OR
- Must have an EMT certificate or greater and as a condition of the position, must attend an accredited Firefighter I Academy and obtain a course completion certificate within three years of start date.
- Must have current BLS Provider (Health care provider CPR)
- Must have Valid California Class C (or greater) Driver's License

Selection:

To apply: A completed River Delta application and resume must be received along with proof that minimum qualifications are met (certificates).
