In our Savannah, GA, storage units, we keep donated Artificial Limbs and Orthopedic Braces that we tear down to use for parts for custom fabricated legs and braces to fit patients in the villages in Mexico's Yucatan and Chiapas regions, Colombia, and also in Guatemala. On October 28th, with the help of generous volunteers, we were able to discard all unusable equipment and to organize the viable supplies. Our goal is to donate our surplus to ministries that share in **Our Mission** to promote independence & self-sustainability.

Through your financial support, **PIPO Missions** was able to make **two** separate trips to **Chiapas & Yucatan**, **Mexico** and **one** trip to **Guatemala**. In doing so, we provided medical care & treatment to over **37 patients**! We were also able to provide non-medical charity **to an** <u>additional</u> **125** people! (clothing, toys, food, and financial assistance)









Although his life was spared, Aldo lost his left arm (to the shoulder) and his right leg (below the knee) and needed to undergo extensive reparatory surgery on his left foot and right hand. His surgery was a success and in late January 2018, David will make a brace for Aldo's left foot and deliver his definitive Below Knee Prosthesis to Guatemala.
