In our Savannah, GA, storage units, we keep donated Artificial Limbs and Orthopedic Braces that we tear down to use for parts for custom fabricated legs and braces to fit patients in the villages in Mexico's Yucatan and Chiapas regions, Colombia, and also in Guatemala. On October 28th, with the help of generous volunteers, we were able to discard all unusable equipment and to organize the viable supplies. Our goal is to donate our surplus to ministries that share in Our Mission to promote independence & self-sustainability.

Fourteen year-old Aldo was severely shocked and nearly

lost his life to electrocution while chopping & clearing branches nearby his home in May of 2017.

Although his life was spared, Aldo lost his left arm (to the shoulder) and his right leg (below the knee) and needed to undergo extensive reparatory surgery on his left foot and right hand. His surgery was a success and in late January 2018, David will make a brace for Aldo's left foot and deliver his definitive Below Knee Prosthesis to Guatemala.
