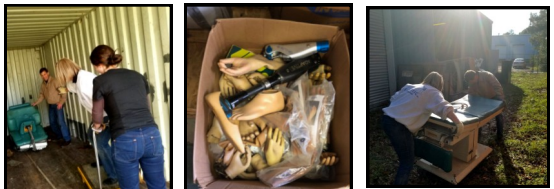
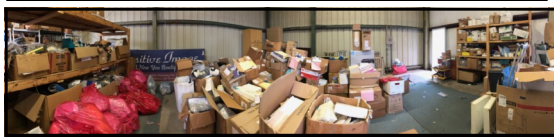

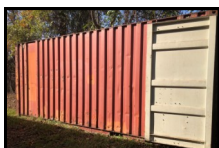

Aldo was severely shocked and nearly lost his life to electrocution while chopping & clearing branches nearby his home in May of 2017. He lost his left arm (to the shoulder) and his right leg (below the knee) and needed to undergo extensive reparatory surgery on his left foot and right hand. In January 2018, David delivered Aldo's definitive Below Knee Prosthesis to Guatemala.

Aldo is doing very well! He is playing soccer and enjoying the mainstream of life. He is losing weight and getting into shape in preparation for his new leg we'll follow-up with and deliver in 2019.
