

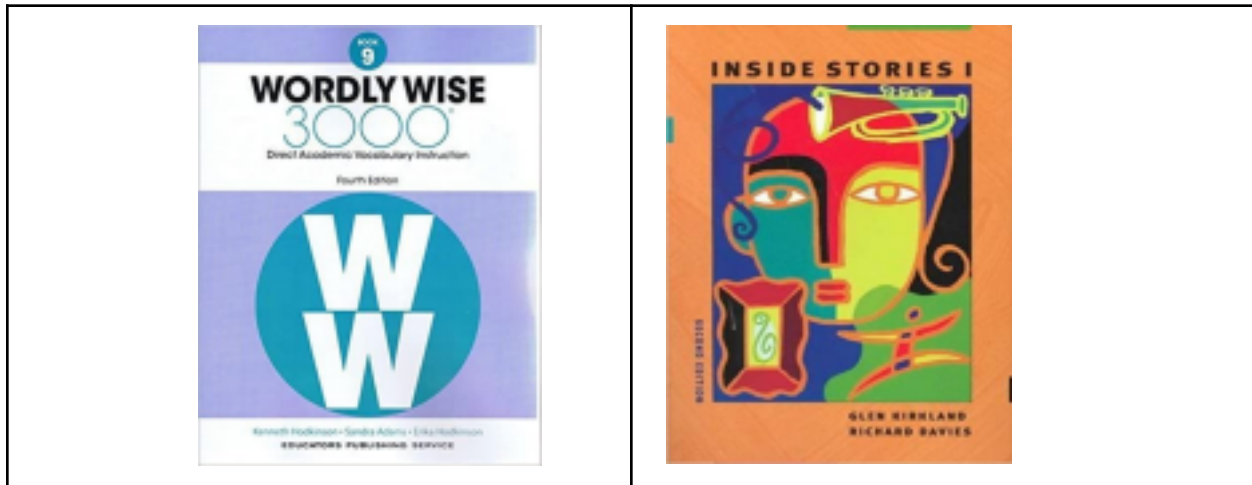
English Reading: Culture and Vocal
