Regarding board meeting scheduled for Sept 24, 2024, pertaining to a 5G cell tower at the intersection of Concho Hwy & White Antelope.

I've been a real estate agent in the White Mountains since July of 2002. Mostly based out of the Snowflake area. During this time, I've worked extensively in the neighborhood on North White Antelope, specifically the EI (Environmental Illness) also known as the MCS (multiple chemical sensitivity) community. I've become very experienced in working with this group of people. I've learned a lot about what harms them and how they need to live. Their homes are custom built to be as inert as possible, to protect them from chemicals and emf radiation.

This neighborhood has been a safe haven for many, due to the good air, water, and lack of pesticides being sprayed on the roads, and APS allowing folks to opt out of smart meters, and local neighbors being respectful of their neighbors needs. The neighborhood is well known across the United States to those with impaired immune systems. I receive numerous inquiries from MCS people looking for safe housing to buy or rent and there is rarely availability due to so many searching for safe housing with limited supply.

These unique homes assess at a higher price than standard housing, due to the specialized materials and the way they are built. This neighborhood, well known as a "safe" area for sensitive people, will be largely impacted with a 5G cell tower constructed near by their homes, and next to their access to their neighborhood and next to their mail boxes. Most of these folks need mail boxes due to the health risk in going to the post office. Their property values will decrease significantly and their ability to sell their homes will also decrease significantly. Their neighborhood would no longer be recognized as and considered a "safe" neighborhood.
