





Our optional "How to Audition"
workshops are group classes where
actors can practice their audition pieces
and receive personalized feedback to
refine their performance. These
workshops also help performers get
comfortable with the audition process
and build confidence. If the production
includes dance, participants will get an
early start learning choreography
combinations.





**Will my child have a guaranteed role in your productions?** Currently, for our production Frozen Jr., all performers who enroll will be a part of the cast. Auditions are for placement purposes only. The Lighting Thief is audition based, not all performers who audition will be cast in the show.

My child is 6-7, do they audition for Frozen Jr. If they feel ready! Our 6-7 year olds are not required to audition, they will be automatically cast in the production as one of our ensemble members. If they are ready, we are ready to watch their audition!

**Do you have a sibling discount?** Yes! If you have siblings signing up for the same production or workshop, there will be a discount automatically applied. \$10 off per sibling in the same class, workshop, or production.

**Do you offer a Military or First Responder discount?** Yes! We offer a 10 percent off of all tuition (excluding private lessons) with valid proof of ID if you are Military or First Responders. Please send inquiries to info@frontrowcenter.live.

**Can you combine discounts?** Yes, you can receive the military discount and the sibling discount. Please send inquiries to info@frontrowcenter.live

I can only do Session 1 of classes, will my performer still be able to participate in the recital? And is the recital mandatory? Unfortunately, no. performers must be enrolled in Session 2 to participate in the recital. The recital is NOT mandatory, please be sure to let FRC creative staff know if you aren't able to perform in the recital.

What happens if our schedule changes and we aren't able to commit to the production? All paid tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable. Our registration day is designed to allow the flexibility to reserve your spot without having to pay an entire production fee up front.

Why are you charging an audition fee for your advanced productions if there is a possiblity my performer wont be cast in the production? The audition fee is there to ensure that you will attend your audition. It ensures a level of dedication and seriousness about participation in the audition process. This audition fee then gets applied to the production fee. If your performer does not receive a role in our production, then the audition fee will be placed as a credit on your account for future programming and/or future auditions!

Will you be double casting the shows and why do you do it?

Double casting a show is a great way to give more opportunities to our performers. The decision of double casting is always dependant on enrollment numbers and who auditions.
