Additional COVID 19 Procedures for 2020 Pool Use

<u>Pool hours for 2020</u> – Monday through Sunday 11am to 3pm and 4pm to 8pm. The pool will close daily from 3 pm until 4 pm for cleaning and disinfecting. During the time that the pool is closed for cleaning and sanitizing all residents must leave the pool area.

Only residents in good standing and registered renters with badges will be allowed to use the pool. At this time, no guests will be permitted. Children 13 and under must be accompanied by an adult (16 years or older)

In keeping with COVID 19 restrictions the **pool capacity** will be limited to 75 people.

Anyone using the pool is required to **sign a waiver**, which will be kept on file at the pool. Waivers will be available at the pool, the office and are attached to this email. Children under 18 must have a parent or guardian signature on their waiver. Upon entering the pool each person must sign in with the pool attendant at the entrance.

Masks are required to use the bathrooms, at the concession stand and when entering and exiting the pool area. They are not required to be worn when in the water. Lifeguards will not be required to wear a mask when seated on the stand so please keep social distance from them and do not attempt to speak with them unless you are wearing a mask. Face masks are required when using the bathroom facilities. Only one person is allowed in the bathroom at a time, except young children can be accompanied by 1 adult.

Chairs and picnic tables will not be available this year. Please feel free to bring your own chairs, blankets and towels. Your party should stay together and remain 6 feet apart from others

The baby pool is closed for the season due to social distancing restrictions. If not toilet trained infants and toddlers must wear swimming diapers in the pool. An adult must remain within arm's reach of any child wearing a flotation device. The health department rules require that the pool be closed for 24 hours if any fecal matter or vomit is found in the pool.

Concession will be selling prepackaged items only. No bills over \$20.00 will be accepted and exact change is much appreciated. Masks and appropriate social distancing is required at the concession stand.

There will be flags outside the door to indicate if the pool is open. **Green flag** means the pool is open and there is still room for more attendees, a **red flag** means the pool is closed and/or filled to capacity. **This flag system will not be utilized for weather related closings.**

Please stay home if you are sick or have tested positive for COVID.

Residents not adhering to these guidelines will be asked to leave and they may forfeit their pool privileges for the remainder of the season. Please adhere to these rules so that the pool can remain open for all to enjoy.
