

Troop 719 Suggested Camping Packing List

Please label EVERYTHING with your scout's name - lots of scouts have identical gear.

General:

- Backpack, or duffle bag to carry items
- Scoutbook
- Small Notebook/Pen/Pencil
- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Camp Chair
- Small Folding Knife & Totin' Chip
- Small Personal First Aid Kit
- Whistle
- Cards, Mini Chess Set, Uno (games for down time)

Clothing:

- Class A uniform and Class B shirts
- Underwear, socks, and clothes for how many days you will be camping
- Something to sleep in
- Hat (for warmth or sun protection)
- Poncho or Raincoat
- Warm Jacket or Coat or Hoodie for cool evenings
- Gloves (activity/winter?)
- Durable shoes (extra pair if rain expected?)
- Trash bag for dirty clothes

Toiletries

- Medications (given to Troop Leader w/Medication Form)
- Toothbrush/Tooth Paste
- Comb
- DEODORANT (NOT OPTIONAL)
- Sunscreen
- Insect Repellent
- Washcloth/Towel/Soap in a container

Eating:

- Mess Kit (Cup, Bowl, Plate, Knife, Fork, Spoon, Mesh bag)
- Water Bottle

Sleeping (packed in a clean garbage bag to keep clean/dry):

- Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Sleeping pad
- Waterproof Tarp, Ground Cloth or Plastic Sheet (under tent)

Troop Will Provide:

- Tents
- Cooking Supplies
- Tables
- Canopies

Troop Provides Food:

Scouts who were designated as the chef for each patrol during the meetings before the trip will buy the food and bring it on the trip.

These Scouts will bring their receipts to the following troop meeting to be reimbursed.

Scouts will eat and clean up in patrols, and everyone is asked to help with preparing the food and cleaning up after the meals on trips.

- Swim Suit

- Spending Money (Most Scouts enjoy a few treats from the Scout Shop)
