The Board discussed trying to get the County involved. Alternative routes could possibly be established but it would be a big undertaking. Further discussion regarding Calle De Lobo as a possibility but a route would need to go through private property.

Susan Frommer reported that she would like some sort of escort service available in case of emergencies, noting that evacuations sites cannot be established until the location of the fire is determined.

Director McDaniel stated that when a meeting is established with LAFCO, he will see if they could give the District direction and help with this matter.

H. General Manager's Report -

Staff reported that work on an emergency contact list was being constructed and reported an incident on Calle Bandido outside of District where police officers where trying to get ahold of someone because a tree fell and was blocking the road. Staff tried to contact La Cresta HOA's property manager however there was no response and no emergency number.

Staff would like to have an emergency contact person on this list for Tenaja so that should something happen after office hours the problem would be taken care of. Staff asked Susan Frommer for assistance since she has many contacts.

The Board discussed having Rene Management as an emergency contact for Tenaja and possibly one more alternative.
