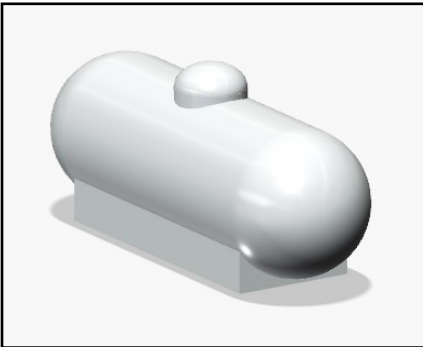


Propane Tank Paint & Placard



Propane Tank arrives unpainted with a white strong & flexible finish only.

Finish Instructions:

1. Spray the whole tank with a glossy white plastic paint. (I use Rustoleum 2x ultra cover.)
2. After paint dries, brush-paint the top dome with a orange or red color paint with a small brush. (I use Testors model paint.)
3. Print this file page on glossy photo paper.
4. Cut out the number of placards you need and simply glue them to each side of the tank using a white, clear drying glue. I use Elmer's white glue with a mini Q-Tip and tweezers. All of the emblems are the same and size to fit this model. (You may have to be vigilant as the tops of the placards tend to pop out during glue drying.)
