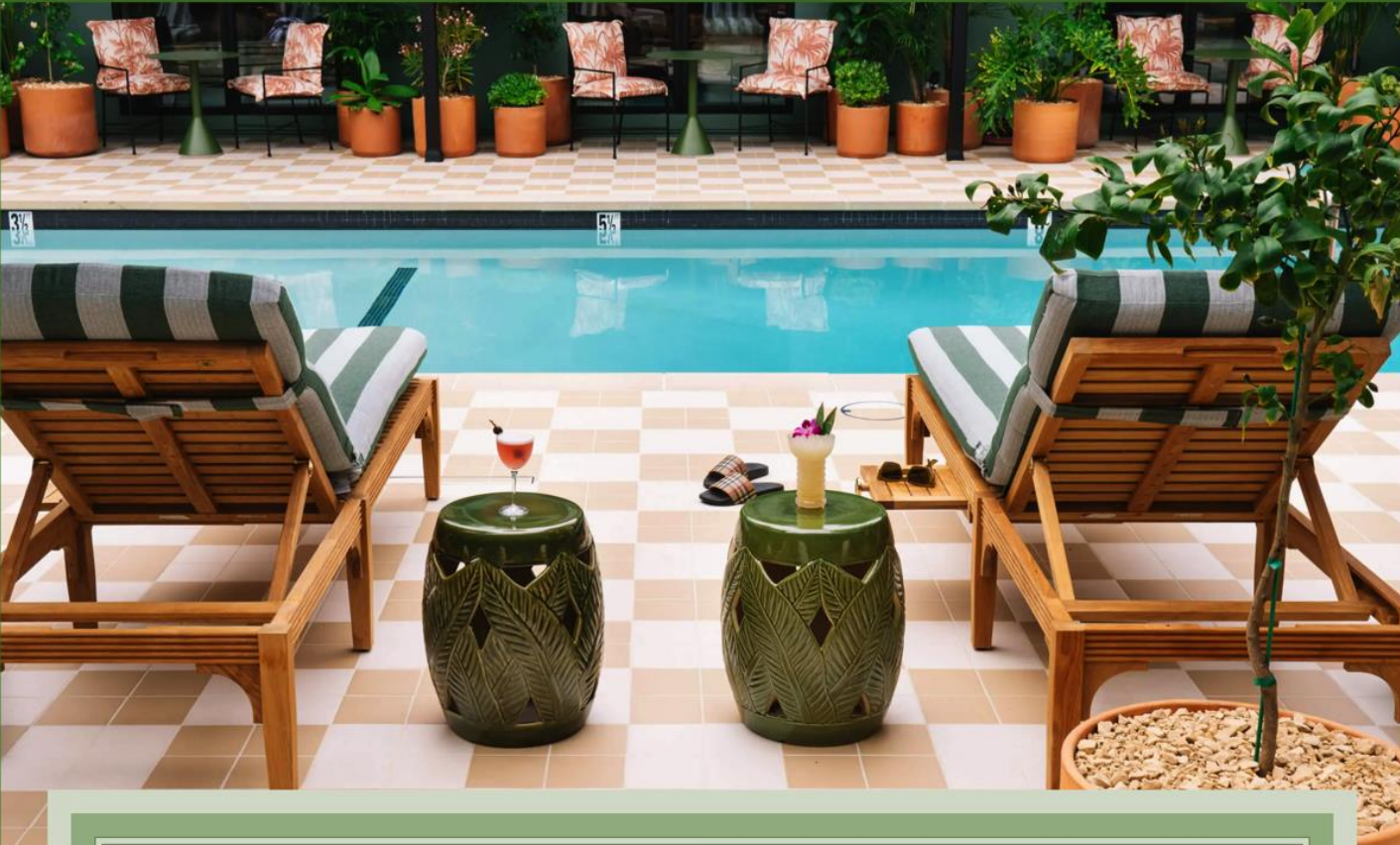

Ambassador Award Recipient 2026



Jabdriel Zapata, AIA

Jay was born and raised in Panama City, where he was inspired to become an architect by visiting construction sites at a very young age. During that time, he was fascinated by how multiple building trades came together to achieve a common goal but more impressed by how they followed directions from everyone called “the architect”. He has received multiple awards for his high achievements in the architectural world and for his involvement as an advocate for the architect’s profession. During the summer of 2024, he was recognized in Washington, DC, with the Young Architect Award presented by the American Institute of Architects at the National Building Museum.

Jay began his professional career in 2006 as a production coordinator at

Pinzón Lozano & Asociados Arquitectos, working on the innovative F&F Tower, a 52-floor corkscrew skyscraper with each floor rotating approximately 9 degrees in Panama City. He graduated with a bachelor's degree in architecture from the University of Panama in 2009. Jay's path took him to the City of Los Angeles to work as a consultant for The Getty Institute at the iconic Getty Center in Brentwood, California, in the spring of 2010. He played an important role assisting in the Institute's Seismic Retrofitting Project: comprehensive damage and construction assessments for four historic earthen sites in the country of Peru representing building typologies found in the Latin American's region. By the end of 2011, Jay was hired by Home and Garden Television Network (HGTV) to work as a consultant for the television show The Outdoor Room with Jamie Durie.

Jay acquired his accreditation from the Green Building Council Institute in April 2012 as a LEED Accredited Professional in Building Design & Construction. He also made his comeback into commercial architecture that same year, landing a job at AC Martin (formerly known as Togawa Smith & Martin), an architecture firm that specializes in high-density multifamily residential and mixed-use buildings throughout Southern California. He was also recognized by the firm's high achievement award individual in 2015 for his contributions to the company.

Jay founded zprout/s-prout/architecture in March 2015, and he currently serves the company as founding principal with his studio located in San Gabriel, California, supported by a small staff of professionals. The company's goal is to assist their clients sprout new ideas to make their vision a reality. Zprout architecture specializes in multifamily developments, commercial architecture, and federal funded projects on all phases of design and construction. In March 2021, the company received certification by the US Small Business Administration to participate in their small business development program. This certification has allowed the company to grow as a Certified Federal contracting firm and to do business with the General Services Administration (GSA).

Jay currently resides in the architecturally historic city of Pasadena, where he lives with his 3 young children and his wife Jamie. He served as president of the American Institute of Architects Pasadena chapter in 2019.

Ivett Busby Arango

Born in Panama and graduated from the Panama School with a bachelor's degree in Bilingual Secretarial with a Specialization in Accounting. After 18 years of experience and a fulfilled life, she decided to give up everything and start from scratch in Los Angeles.

Ivett moved to Los Angeles in December 2005. After a divorce and a suitcase full of dreams and an immense desire to start over and take on the world, in 2010, she got enrolled in Pasadena City College and graduated with 3 vocational careers: Business Office Systems, Clerical Receptionist, and Bookkeeping Assistant.

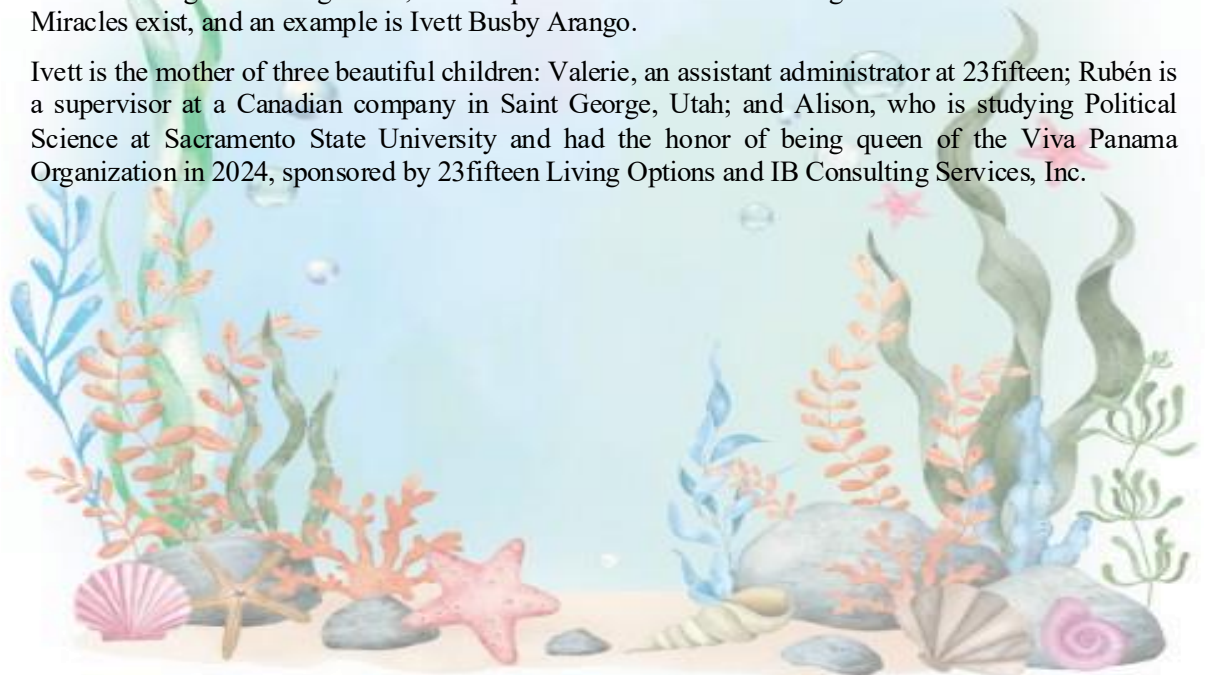
That same year, she began working at 23Fifteen Living Options, formerly called Smith Family Homes, as a caregiver; later, its owner and CEO, Jason Smith, allowed her to manage the only house he had at that time for people with physical and mental disabilities.

In 2012, she was diagnosed with scleroderma accompanied by 10 other incurable conditions, which, despite having no cure, have been controlled with chemotherapy and infusions for the rest of her life, with the unconditional support of her children, her daughter-in-law Keren, and her cousin Anayka.

Today, 23fifteen Living Options has a total of 9 facilities, and Ivett holds the position of General Manager in the Los Angeles area.

She thanks God for the illness she has, because it touched her and not any of her children, and because it could have been a terminal illness. Her message to all people is that, to succeed in life, you only need to have God in your heart and a positive attitude towards life, because life is the most beautiful thing that God gave us, and no person or disease has the right to take control of our life. Miracles exist, and an example is Ivett Busby Arango.

Ivett is the mother of three beautiful children: Valerie, an assistant administrator at 23fifteen; Rubén is a supervisor at a Canadian company in Saint George, Utah; and Alison, who is studying Political Science at Sacramento State University and had the honor of being queen of the Viva Panama Organization in 2024, sponsored by 23fifteen Living Options and IB Consulting Services, Inc.

Antonio Andrés Rosello

Antonio Andrés Rosello is a Venezuelan-Italian actor, producer, creator, and digital communicator who grew up much of his life between Europe and Panama and considers the country one of the greatest influences on his personal and artistic training. He is fluent in Spanish, English, Italian, and French, and has built an international career that unites film, television, digital platforms, and social work.

She began her artistic career in Panamanian commercial theater, participating in numerous stage productions that sparked her passion for acting and storytelling. Later, he leaped into film and television, developing a career that today includes more than 40 short films, feature films, television productions, and digital series in the United States, Panama, and Latin America.

Master of Ceremony

His work has been presented at major international festivals, including the Panama International Film Festival (IFF Panama), the Palm Springs International Short Fest, the BFI Flare Film Festival in the United Kingdom, and the Los Angeles Film Festival (LAFA), bringing Latin American and Panamanian stories to audiences around the world.

His performances have received international recognition, winning awards for Best Actor at the Berlin Indie Film Festival and the Los Angeles Film Awards for his work in independent film. He has also participated in outstanding film productions and continues to promote Panama's talent and stories on international stages.

In addition to his facet as an actor, Antonio is the producer and creator of an original fiction series inspired by football and developed for new short-form digital entertainment platforms, a project that merges two of his great passions: sport and audiovisual narration.

He has also worked with renowned international brands such as Ralph Lauren, Samsung, Tommy Hilfiger and Garnier, consolidating a versatile career between acting, advertising and content creation.

Committed to service and social impact, Antonio has had the honor of serving as an Ambassador for the Panamanian Red Cross, using his platform to support humanitarian initiatives and inspire new generations of artists and leaders in the region.

As a digital creator, he has built a community of more than 750,000 followers on TikTok and more than 45,000 followers on Instagram, connecting with a global audience in Latin America, the United States, and Europe through content on acting, creativity, sports, and personal development.

He holds a degree in Marketing from Florida State University, with complementary studies in Film and Humanities. She has also perfected her acting training at the prestigious Stella Adler Academy of Acting in Los Angeles, one of the most prestigious the world's most renowned performing institutions and heir to the legacy of the legendary teacher Stella Adler.

Currently, Antonio continues to develop his international career from Los Angeles, always maintaining a strong link with Panama and working with the purpose of telling stories that inspire, generate positive impact, and represent the talent, diversity, and resilience of the communities that have marked his life.

Proclamation of International Week of Panama



On August 12, 2003, during the Celebration of Panama's Centennial and under the initiative of Viva Panama Organization's President and his collaborators, a motion to the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors was placed suggesting the **Proclamation of International Week of Panama in Los Angeles**, which was declared by the Chair of the board, Ms. Yvonne Burke, as a commemoration of Panama's Centennial and the Foundation of the Old Panama City on August 15, 1519.

We had the presence of Ing. Dominador Kaiser Bazan, Vice-President of Panama, Lic. Fernando Daly, Consul of Panama in Los Angeles, Eduardo Pineda, representative of the Board of Supervisors, Justine Pasek, Miss Universe 2002, and Dr. Victor Grimaldo, President of Viva Panama Organization.

Every year in August, VPO hosts two events to celebrate the International Week of Panama in Los Angeles: the **Ambassador Awards & Film Festival Opening Night Event**, recognizing high-profile Panamanians with the *Ambassador Awards for* their professional achievements and contributions to the community in Panama, USA, and/or worldwide.

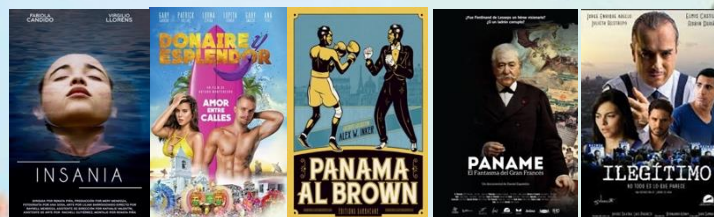

Urracá Institute Musical Band



The history of the General Omar Torrijos Herrera Music Band of the Urracá Institute is the reflection of more than half a century of effort, discipline, and commitment to musical excellence.

Its origins date back to 1965, when Professor José Luis Rodríguez Vélez, visionary educator and passionate promoter of the arts, promoted the acquisition of the first musical instruments for the then newly founded Urracá Institute. That initiative sowed the seed of a project that, over the years, would become one of the most representative student groups in Panama.

In 1970, under the direction of Professor Luzmila Díaz de Pinzón, and thanks to the constant support of Professor Rodríguez Vélez, the band was officially born. In recognition of the support provided by the national government and by General Omar Torrijos Herrera to the educational development of the country, the group proudly adopts the name that distinguishes it today.

For more than five decades, the General Omar Torrijos Herrera Music Band has transcended the borders of its province and its nation, taking the name of the Urracá Institute and Panama to important national and international stages. Its trajectory includes outstanding participations in competitions, festivals and musical meetings in Panama, Colombia and Costa Rica, consolidating itself as a benchmark of artistic excellence, comprehensive training and youth development.

Throughout its history, generations of students have found in this group a space to cultivate values such as discipline, leadership, teamwork and love for music. Its growth has been possible thanks to the legacy of directors and educators who dedicated their talent and vocation to the training of hundreds of young musicians, including its founder, Professor José Luis Rodríguez Vélez (r.i.p.), as well as teachers Bolívar Díaz, Julio Zamora, Omar Morales and many others who left an indelible mark on this institution.

Today, with 75 members and a solid tradition of excellence, the band continues to write new pages of its history under the direction of maestro Abdías José Chang Lima, professional musician, academic and cultural promoter, who has strengthened its training process through a modern vision of music education and a constant search for artistic growth.

More than a musical group, the General Omar Torrijos Herrera Music Band represents the pride of an educational community, the heritage of generations of musicians and the permanent commitment to continue transforming lives through art.
