1. 6 **Young men** likewise **exhort** to be **sober**(to curb one's \_\_\_\_\_) minded.
2. 7 In all things shewing thyself a **pattern of good works**:
3. In **doctrine** *shewing* uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity,
4. 8 **Sound speech**, that **cannot be condemned**; that he that is of the contrary part may be ashamed,
5. Having no evil thing to say of you.

2. *And to please them* well in all *things*;
3. Not answering again; (**BACKTALK**)
4. 10 Not **purloining**(divided; embezzle), but shewing all good **fidelity(faith)**; that they may **adorn the doctrine of God our Saviour in all things**.
