5. Joshua and Satan (Zechariah 3:1–7)

a. The Scene (Zechariah 3:1)

1 And he shewed me **Joshua**(Jehovah _____) the **high priest** standing before the angel of the LORD, and **Satan** standing at his **right hand**(position of _____) to resist(_____) him.

b. The Status (Zechariah 3:2-7)

1) _____ **Rebuke** - **The Lord Rebukes Satan (Zechariah 3:2)**

2 And the LORD said unto Satan, **The LORD rebuke thee, O Satan**; even the LORD that hath **chosen Jerusalem** rebuke thee: is not this a **brand plucked out of the fire**?

2) _____ (set apart for _____ service) **Man (Zechariah 3:3-6)**

3 Now Joshua was clothed with **filthy garments**, and stood before the angel.

4 And he answered and spake unto those that stood before him, saying, **Take away the filthy garments from him**. And unto him he said, Behold, I have caused **thine iniquity** to pass from thee, and **I will clothe thee with change of raiment**.

5 And I said, Let them set a **fair**(_____) **mitre**(_____) upon his head. So they set a fair mitre upon his head, and clothed him with garments. **And the angel of the LORD stood by**.

6 And the angel of the LORD **protested**(_____) unto Joshua, saying,

3) _____ **Symbol – Our Potential _____ with God (Zechariah 3:7)**

7 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; If thou wilt walk in my ways, and if thou wilt keep my charge, then thou shalt also **judge my house**, and shalt also **keep my courts**, and **I will give thee places to walk among these that stand by**.

6. The Branch & The Stone (Zechariah 3:8–10)

a. The Branch _____

8 Hear now, O Joshua the high priest, thou, and thy fellows that sit before thee: for they are men wondered at: for, behold, **I will bring forth my servant the BRANCH**(_____).

- **Isaiah 11:1** And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a **Branch**(_____) shall grow out of his roots:
- **John 15:1-6** I am the true **vine**(_____), and my Father is **the husbandman**.
- **Matthew 1:18** Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, **she was found with child of the Holy Ghost**.

b. The Stone _____

9a For behold **the stone** that I have laid before Joshua; upon one stone shall be seven eyes: behold, I will engrave the graving thereof, saith the LORD of hosts,

- **Daniel 2:34** Thou sawest till that **a stone was cut out without hands**, which **smote the image** upon his feet that were of iron and clay, and **brake them to pieces**.
- **Daniel 2:45** Forasmuch as thou sawest **that the stone was cut out of the mountain without hands**, and that it brake in pieces the iron, the brass, the clay, the silver, and the gold; the great God hath made known to the king what shall come to pass hereafter: and the dream is certain, and the interpretation thereof sure.
- **Psalms 118:22** **The stone which the builders refused is become the head stone of the corner**.
- **Isaiah 28:16** Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD, **Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious corner stone, a sure foundation**: he that believeth shall not make haste.
- **Acts 4:11** **This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner**.
- **I Peter 2:7** Unto you therefore which believe **he is precious**: but unto them which be disobedient, **the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner**,

Revelation 19:11-21

11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called **Faithful and True**, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called **The Word of God**.

14 And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, **that with it he should smite the nations:** and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

16 And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, **KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.**

17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, **Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;**

18 That ye may eat **the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses,** and of them that sit on them, and **the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.**

19 And **I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies,** gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

20 And **the beast was taken,** and with him **the false prophet** that wrought miracles before him, with which **he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast,** and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

21 And **the remnant were slain** with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

Revelation 20:1-3

1 And I saw **an angel come down from heaven,** having **the key of the bottomless pit** and a great chain in his hand.

2 And **he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,**

3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

18 I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.
