Zechariah 2:1-13

1 I lifted up mine eyes again, and looked, and behold a man with a measuring (_____) line in his hand.

2 Then said I, **Whither goest thou?** And he said unto me, **To measure Jerusalem**, to see what is the **breadth**(_____) thereof, and what is the **length**(_____) thereof.

3 And, behold, **the angel that talked with me went forth**, and **another angel** went out to meet him,

4 And said unto him, **Run**(_____), **speak to this young man**, saying, **Jerusalem** shall be inhabited as **towns without walls** for the multitude of men and cattle therein:

a. Protection (Zechariah 2:5-9)

5 For **I**, saith the LORD, **will be unto her a wall of fire round about**, and **will be the glory in the midst of her**.

6 **Ho, ho, come forth**, and **flee from the land of the north**, saith the LORD: for I have **spread you abroad** as the **four winds of the heaven**, saith the LORD.

7 **Deliver thyself**, O Zion, that **dwellest with** the **daughter of Babylon**.

8 For thus saith the LORD of hosts; **After the glory hath he sent me unto the nations which spoiled you: for he that toucheth you toucheth the apple of his eye**.

9 For, behold, **I will shake mine hand upon them**, and **they shall be a spoil to their servants: and ye shall know that the LORD of hosts hath sent me**.

10 Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion: for, lo, **I come**, and **I will dwell in the midst of thee**, saith the LORD.

Psalms 98:1-3

1 A Psalm. O sing unto the LORD a new song; for **he hath done marvellous things: his right hand, and his holy arm, hath gotten him the victory**.

2 The **LORD hath made known his salvation: his righteousness hath he openly shewed in the sight of the heathen**.

3 He hath remembered his mercy and his truth **toward the house of Israel: all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.**

13 Be silent, O all flesh, before the LORD: **for he is raised up out of his holy habitation.**

I Peter 2:9-10

9 But ye are **a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people;** that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

10 Which **in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God:** which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.
